

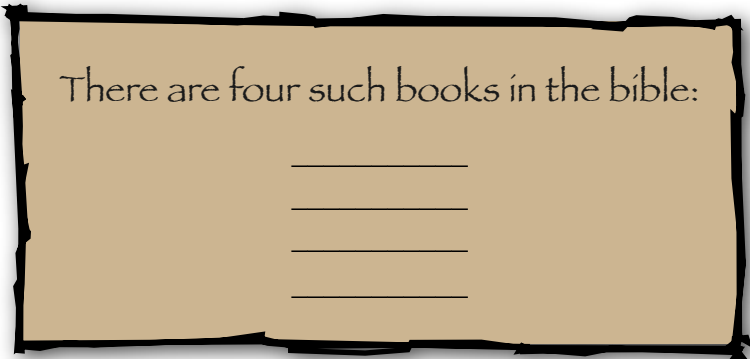

Four Approaches of Interpreting Revelation

1. _____ - having hidden spiritual meaning that transcends the literal sense of a sacred text. It is like a fairy tale, myth or fable.
2. _____ - The name for this approach comes a past verb tense. It views the early church fulfilling the book of Revelation. In this view, Revelation culminated in 70 A.D. when the Romans destroyed the Temple and devastated Jerusalem. This approach denies any future events being foretold in Revelation.
3. _____ - This approach uses those symbols in the book as pictures of the total Church age that leads up to the Second Coming of Christ. No Bible teachers using this approach can agree on which events aligning with which prophecies.
4. _____ - This approach looks at the book of Revelation as literal, sensible and normal. The Premillennial approach means Jesus comes back to the earth before the Millennial Kingdom.



The False Church - *Revelation 17*

Whore is used ____ times in this chapter, the word woman ____ times, each referring to an unvirtuous woman - the opposite of a pure bride. These are referring to the false church.

History of Mystery Babylon - Mother of Harlots

After the flood, God told Noah and his family to fill the earth.

Noah's great grandson, Nimrod, violated that command and set up a city, Babel, for all people on the earth. This became his kingdom, in other words a one world government. - Genesis 11

The Tower of Babel was a one world religion, with man trying to reach Heaven. This religion began to worship Nimrod, and his wife Semiramis, and their son, Tamuz. This was the first mother-son cult - the basis for all false religions.

When Ezekiel returns to Jerusalem and the Temple, he sees all kinds of idolatrous portraits on the walls, including a convent of virgins worshipping Tamuz. - Ezekiel 8

Babel later became known as Babylon, and is alive and well today in modern-day Iraq.

This false Babylonian religion moved its headquarters to Pergamus in 539 B.C., where they started to deify the Roman emperors. Their political name was Caesar. Their religious name was Pontifus Maximus, shortened to Pontiff and later to Pope, and they had a convent of virgins.

The woman (the false church) is described in with headquarters in Rome the first 3.5 years of the Tribulation period headed by Antichrist. - Revelation 17:4

The revived Roman empire will rise up and destroy the false church. - Revelation 17:16


CONCLUSION

- In place are Satan, Antichrist and then the false prophet who uses signs, wonders and miracles to deceive the entire world when the Antichrist comes to power. The Antichrist is the fulfillment of this first seal judgment, establishing peace, a false church in the city of Rome and starting everything moving into the Tribulation period. At the same time believers will be celebrating the marriage supper of the Lamb.
- The Rapture of the church is the next main event on God's calendar of activities.
- Prepare your wedding gown with acts of righteousness done in His power, for His glory, and thus be adorned in the beauty of holiness as you stand before your groom (Jesus Christ) when He comes to take His bride (the church) unto Himself.

The War In Heaven

- At the end of the first half of the Tribulation, at the 3.5 year mark, _____ and his angels go to war with Satan and his angels. - *Revelation 12:7-9*

The origin of angels

Angels are created beings.

Colossians 1:16; Genesis 1, Job 38:4, 7.

God created heaven, then angels, and then the earth.

Angels are not mentioned in the Genesis creation account because they were already there. Until at least the 7th day, all angels were good, none had fallen yet. Lucifer, the most prominent of all the cherubim of God, was in heaven praising God for His creation.

Isaiah 14 and Ezekiel 28

Then Lucifer rebelled against God and tried to usurp His authority and showed up sometime between Genesis 1:31 and 3:1.

At the mid-point of the Tribulation he will lead a mighty army of evil angels, 1/3 of all the angels ever created.

Revelation 12:9

- Michael and his good angels _____ and throw Satan and his evil angels (demons) out of the heavens. - Revelation 12:7-9
- They were cast out of the third heaven into the first or second heaven, where Satan dispatches his evil angels, against whom we battle - Ephesians 6:12.



The Rise And Fall of Babylon

- It started 4,500 years ago with a one-world government ruler and religious leader, _____, the great grandson of Noah in the city of Babylon.
- In 605 B.C. _____, King of Babylon, takes captive Daniel and three Hebrew young men into Babylon. The Babylonian captivity of the Jewish people begins the times of the Gentiles. In 597 B.C. he takes Ezekiel and 10,000 Jews into captivity, and in 586 B.C. he and his army destroy Jerusalem and the Temple and take all of the Jews into Babylonian captivity.
- Later _____, Nebuchadnezzar's grandson comes to power and put on a banquet spread for about 1,000 of his best friends. He called for the implements used for the sacrificial system in the Temple in Jerusalem to put their liquor in as they continued their drunken party.
- The Medes and Persians dammed up the _____ River that ran through Babylon, entered through the dried up riverbed and defeated the Babylonians. That was the end of the Babylonian empire.
- However, it was not the end of the city of Babylon. Ezra lived there 75 years later. 200 years later _____ the Great defeated the Medo-Persian empire. 500 years later Peter lived there. - *Ezra 7, 1 Peter 5:13*
- Isaiah and Jeremiah prophesy that Babylon will be destroyed. A description of Babylon is given in that it shall no more be inhabited forever. This prophecy has yet to be fulfilled. - *Isaiah 13, 14 & Jeremiah 50:1,13, 39 - 40; 51:29, 37 & 43*

Babylon The Great

- It is modern day Iraq, 58 miles southwest of Baghdad.
- The first 3.5 years the Antichrist will be headquartered in Rome heading up a one-world religion, ecclesiastical Babylon, the mother-son cult that started in _____ by Nimrod, his wife Semiramis and their son Tamuz. - *Revelation 17:9*
- Babylon the great is _____ and become the habitation of devils. - *Revelation 18:1, 2*
- Revelation 17 talks about the false church. When she is destroyed, no one cries.
- Revelation 18 speaks of a governmental, economic political system ruled by the Antichrist in Babylon. When she is _____, the merchants of the church are very, very sorrowful.



Babylon is fallen

- At the mid-point of the seven year Tribulation period the Antichrist goes to Jerusalem, disgraces and desecrates the _____ and claims to be like the most high God.
- The false prophet puts a statue in the _____ of _____ and performs miracles, signs and wonders causing the world to worship that image of the beast, and to take his mark 666. - *Revelation 17*
- The Antichrist leaves _____ and goes to Babylon to set up his one-world economic, political, governmental system the last 3.5 years.
- Babylon will be destroyed because the Babylonians desecrated those implements that had been taken from the Jewish _____ in Jerusalem. - *Isaiah 13 & 14; Jeremiah 50 & 51*
- Babylon will be destroyed in one _____, taking the riches of the world with it. - *Revelation 18:10, 17, 19*

The seventh vial judgment

- The six vial judgments conclude with the kings of the East coming across the dried up _____ River into Jerusalem to join all the armies of the world. - *Revelation 16*
- God pours out His wrath through storms and the greatest _____ ever since man were upon the earth. Hailstones weighing 100 pounds fall from heaven, and still the survivors blaspheme God. This is the last judgment before the return of Jesus Christ. - *Revelation 16:17-21*
- Iraq is an oil rich nation that will make her one of the richest nations in the world. Babylon will be destroyed. Satan, Antichrist and the false prophet flee to Jerusalem for the purpose of gathering the armies of the world to take on the return of Jesus Christ.

The Campaign of Armageddon

- God will gather all nations against _____ to battle. The city will be taken, and half the city's population will go into captivity. - *Zechariah 14:1, 2*
- A conservative estimate is 100 _____ soldiers will gather with Antichrist, Satan and the false prophet at Jerusalem to take on the returning Christ. - *Zechariah 14:3 and Revelation 19:11, 14*
- Christ will stand in that day upon the Mount of _____ east of Jerusalem. The Mount will split, and all the gathered armies will flee to the valley of the mountains – the Jezreel Valley 14 miles wide and 67 miles long (1,000 square miles). - *Zechariah 14:5*
- Jesus is going to _____ Jerusalem. It is 8.5 square miles now. It will be lifted up according to Ezekiel to 2,500 square miles (50 miles on each side).
- The Temple Mount will be lifted up one mile and there Jesus will build His 21-story Temple. - *Zechariah 6:12 & 14:10, and Ezekiel 40-46*
- The armies of the world retreat to _____.
- He goes to the Jezreel Valley and kills the armies of the nations.
- _____ is Petra today, an impregnable city prepared by God to protect the Jewish people in the last 3.5 years. Jesus is the one coming from Bozrah to Jerusalem. - *Revelation 12:6*
- From the battle field of Armageddon to the entrance of Petra is 176 miles. Jesus goes there, gathers up those protected Jews and brings them to Jerusalem.
- They enter through the _____ Gate to the Temple Jesus had built, and Jesus then sits on His throne in the Holy of Holies. This concludes the campaign of Armageddon. - *Ezekiel 43:1 and Revelation 1:4, 7*

- The Day of _____ – when Christ destroys the armies of the Gentile nations in the Jezreel Valley, gathers His people at Petra and brings them back into Jerusalem and establishes His Kingdom ruling from His throne in the Holy of Holies.
- The feast of Passover was for _____ salvation. The feast day of Atonement was for national salvation when all the Jewish people will be saved in a day. - *Zechariah 3:9*
- The Millennial Kingdom begins on the day of the Feast of _____.



- The _____ River comes out from underneath the Temple Mount. During the Millennial Kingdom the tree of life in the Garden of Eden will be on the Temple Mount in Jerusalem, a source of food for the survivors of the Tribulation who enter the Millennial Kingdom. - *Revelation 2:7*

The End of the Kingdom

- Satan shall be loosed out of his prison and shall go out to deceive the nations and again gather them together to battle, to once again try to go against Jesus Christ in Jerusalem. - *Revelation 20:7-9*
- Then the devil who deceived the unbelievers is cast into the _____ of _____ and brimstone where the beast and false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night forever. - *Revelation 20:10*
- Hell's fires were prepared for only Satan, Antichrist, the false prophet, and all the evil angels that rebelled with Satan. Humans were never meant to go there. It's only through rejecting God's grace through Christ that man can go there. - *Matthew 25:41*

- There will be a temple forever on the Temple Mount in Jerusalem. - *Ezekiel 37:26, 28*
- There will be no temple in the New Jerusalem. God and the Lamb (Jesus Christ) will be the temple of it. - *Revelation 21:22*
- The feast of _____ will be celebrated throughout eternity future. - *Zechariah 14*
- The New Earth will be the eternal home for the believing Gentiles and Jews.
- The New Jerusalem will be the eternal home for the Christians.
