

No person can be members of two strands at the same time - just one. Ephesians 2:14

Gentiles - the first people

In the first 2,000 years of human history there were only <u>Gentiles</u> upon the face of the earth. *Genesis 1-12*

Ishamel - father of the Arab World?

<u>No</u>. Ishmael's mother was an <u>Egyptian</u> handmaiden. Her name is Hagar. It is difficult for Ishmael to be the father of the <u>Egyptian</u> people if his mother came from <u>Egypt</u>.

Most of the Arab world comes **before** Abraham was on the scene.

Only two peoples come from father Abraham in the Arab world.

- Ishmael became an Arabian in modern-day Saudi Arabia Genesis 25:18
- **Esau** became Edom, believed to be the **Palestinian** people of today.

Origins of the Jewish People

In Genesis 12 is the call of <u>Abraham</u> out of the Ur of the Chaldees near present day Kuwait. His journey takes him over the fertile crescent, through <u>Syria</u> down into Canaan, Modern day <u>Israel</u>.

Three widely used names for the Children of Israel in use today have their origins recorded in God's Word:


Hebrew (First applied to Abram) - Genesis 14:13 Israel (First applied to Jacob) - Genesis 32:28 Jew (From the name of Judah) - II Kings 16:6

A summary of the three strands in human history from the Scriptures

- <u>Gentiles</u> only Genesis 1-12
- Gentiles and Jews Genesis 12 to Acts 2
- Gentiles, Jews and Christians Acts 2 to Revelation 22

Three prophetic books for each of the strands of the human family.

- <u>Revelation</u> unfolds a timeline for the <u>Christian</u>.
- **Ezekiel** predicts the future for the **Jew**.
- **Daniel** focuses on God's plan for the **Gentiles**.



The history leading up to the time of Daniel


- The **Egyptians** were the ruling peoples of the world. They were defeated by the **Assyrians** headquartered in Nineveh.
- They in turn defeated the ten northern tribes of <u>Israel</u> in 722 BC.
- **Babylon**, located in modern day **Iraq** and refurbished today, went against Assyria (modern day **Syria**) and then drove the **Egyptians** south across the land bridge in between called **Israel**.
- Nebuchadnezzar took <u>hostages</u>, including <u>Daniel</u> and the three Hebrew children in 605 BC, <u>Ezekiel</u> and 10,000 Jews in 597 BC, and then in 586 BC wiped out Jerusalem and devastated the temple.

The human author of the book we call "Daniel"

- According to <u>Jesus</u> it is <u>Daniel</u>. *Matthew 24:15*
 - Jesus confirms that <u>Daniel</u> is the author of 3 separate passages of that book.
 - Daniel 9:27; 11:31 and 12:11
- Chapter 11 speaks of five people that **<u>Daniel</u>** prophesied would come to power.

Daniel's literary style

Daniel is <u>apocalyptic</u> literature. It means to <u>unveil</u> or disclose, revealing that which is going to happen. That comes through the use of <u>signs</u> and <u>symbols</u>.




How is one the interpret such literature?

By comparing it with other such literature.

Example: To understand Revelation one must understand Ezekiel.

What two languages were used in writing Daniel?

- <u>Hebrew</u> Daniel 1:1-2:4 and chapters 8-12 These are prophecies to the <u>Jews</u>.
- Aramaic Daniel 2:4 to 7:28
 - These are prophecies to the <u>Gentiles</u>, written in the common language used for commerce, education and daily conversation.
 - In these passages, Daniel is speaking of the "the Times of the <u>Gentiles</u>". (*Compare Luke 21:24*)


The book of Daniel is divided into two parts, and they must go together.

- **Practical** Chapters 1-6
- **Prophetic** Chapters 7-12

CHAPTER 1 – PURPOSE

What was Nebuchadnezzar's great sin?

He takes the **vessels** from the temple, the house of God, to the house of his god.



Young Daniel takes a stand - Daniel 1:8

He **<u>purposed</u>** *in his* <u>heart</u> *that he would not* <u>defile</u> *himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank.*

Young Daniel's creative diplomatic solution

A ten day kosher diet.

This diet resulted in God granting His four faithful followers attributes that were far better than the other captives - even better than all of the king's wise men. They were ten times better in:

- Appearance
- <u>Knowledge</u>
- Skill
- Learning
- Wisdom

CHAPTER 3 - PROTECTION

The stand of the three Hebrew children


They would not <u>serve</u> King Nebuchadnezzar's god nor <u>worship</u> the golden image that he had set up.

As a result, Nebuchadnezzar ordered the furnace heated <u>seven</u> times hotter than normal. *Daniel 3:19*

They were to be **<u>bound</u>** by the most mighty men of Nebuchadnezzar's army and cast into the furnace.

Man cannot be more faithful than God!

- Those who threw the three Hebrew children into the fiery furnace were <u>burned</u> to <u>death</u>. *Daniel 3:22*
- A pre-incarnate appearance of Jesus Christ occurred witnessed by the king. *Daniel 3:25*
- The three Hebrew children came out without even the <u>smell</u> of <u>smoke</u> on them. *Daniel* 3:27
- The king acknowledges the **power** of God and makes a new decree in God's favor. *Daniel* 3:29
- The three Hebrew children are **promoted** in Babylon. *Daniel 3:30*



CHAPTER 4 - PRIDE

The pride of Nebuchadnezzar expressed? Daniel 4:30

...<u>I</u> have built...<u>my</u> power...<u>my</u> majesty.

- Seven palaces
- Fourteen <u>temples</u>
- The hanging gardens in Babylon.

God humbles the mighty king - to the point of being more like an animal than a man - for seven years. - Daniel 4:31 - 32

CHAPTER 5 – PUNISHMENT


The Party is Over.

It is now <u>70</u> years after the events described in the first chapter. Daniel is about <u>85</u> years old. <u>Belshazzar</u>, Nebuchadnezzar's grandson, is the king of Babylon.

In his arrogance, self-confidence, and price, the king throws a party to celebrate himself. To hold the wine for his cronies, the king uses the implements of the Jewish <u>Temple</u>. God swiftly judges and punishes Belshazzar's sin, writing His ruling on the wall.

Mighty Babylon, an impregnable double-walled city with flowing water and a 20 day food supply falls to the <u>Medo-Persian</u> Empire in less than one night.





CHAPTER 6 – PRAYER

Elder Daniel takes a stand

- He was commanded not to **pray** for 30 days. *Daniel 6:7,9*
- ► Daniel **prayed** "as he did **aforetime**". Daniel 6:10
- As a result, he is cast into the lions' den
- God is faithful to protect Daniel by shutting the mouths of the lions.



CONCLUSION

Every prophet in God's Word was a man of convicting faith and prayer. Prophecy is so practical. It gives us purpose in life. It protects us from the punishment that can harm us. It keeps us from pride. It drives us to prayer.

- In his youth Daniel did not compromise his diet. *Daniel 1:8*
- In his old age Daniel did not compromise his devotions. *Daniel 6:10*



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NEBUCHADNEZZAR'S DREAM – An Earthly View – Chapter 2


King Nebuchadnezzar had a troubling <u>dream</u>, and demanded that his wise men, (including Daniel and the three Hebrews), both describe and interpret it. Failure would result in death.

This called for a <u>prayer</u> meeting (*Daniel 2:18*) requesting that Daniel and his fellows should not <u>perish</u> with the rest of the wise men of Babylon.

THE DREAM (Daniel 2:31-35)

In his dream the king saw a great statue.

- The head was of fine **<u>gold</u>**.
- Its breast and arms were of silver.
- Its belly and thighs were of **brass**.
- Its legs were of **iron**.
- Its feet were part **<u>iron</u>** and part <u>**clay**</u>.



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THE INTERPRETATION - Daniel 2:36-45

King Nebuchadnezzar is told that the <u>God</u> of heaven had given him *a kingdom, power and strength and glory. - Daniel 2:37, 4:17*


Daniel begins to lay out before Nebuchadnezzar a <u>timeline</u> looking into the future for the Gentile world powers by telling him, *Thou art this head of gold. - Daniel 2:38*

The **<u>Times</u>** of the <u>Gentiles</u> began with the Babylonian captivity of the Jewish people.

- The **Babylonian** Empire Daniel 2:38
- The Medo-Persian Empire Daniel 2:39
- The Grecian Empire
- Two Divisions of the **<u>Roman</u>** Empire *Daniel 2:40*
- A confederation of ten units forming the revival of the fourth kingdom *Daniel 2:41-43*

The God of heaven will set up a kingdom that shall never be destroyed. - Daniel 2:44,45

The stone cut of the mountain without hands would be <u>Jesus Christ</u> and His kingdom to bring an end to the Gentile world powers at the end of the Tribulation period.



DANIEL'S DREAM – A Heavenly View – Chapter 7

Belshazzar, grandson of Nebuchadnezzar, has come to power. And Daniel has a dream of four **beasts** coming up out of the sea.

- First Beast Daniel 7:4
 - A <u>lion</u> with eagle's wings.
 - The **<u>Babylonian</u>** Empire whose main symbol was a winged <u>lion</u>.
- Second Beast Daniel 7:5
 - A <u>bear</u> raised up on one side with three ribs in its mouth.
 - The <u>Medo-Persian</u> Empire.
 - The three ribs possibly represent the Egyptian, Assyrian and Babylonian Empires.
 - Leaning on one side because the Medes were stronger than the <u>Persians</u>.
- Third Beast Daniel 7:6
 - A <u>leopard</u> with four heads and four wings.
 - The Grecian Empire
 - Swift and flying leopard by age 32 <u>Alexander</u> the Great had come to power over the entire world.
 - Four Heads <u>Alexander</u> died shortly thereafter and his kingdom was divided into four parts.
- Fourth Beast Daniel 7:7
 - Dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth...and it had ten horns...
 - The <u>Roman</u> Empire
 - One horn becomes superior of all the horns, the leader of the original <u>Roman</u> Empire, the Revived <u>Roman</u> Empire and the little horn being the Antichrist.

DANIEL'S VISION – Chapter 8

- During the third year of the reign of King Belshazzar, Daniel was in Shushan, the capital of the <u>Medo-Persian</u> Empire. It was there than Daniel was given a vision from God.
 - Daniel saw a ram that had two horns, One higher than the other. This is the <u>Medo-Persian</u> Empire. *Daniel 8:3, 4, & 20*
 - A goat came up and smote the ram. This is the <u>Grecian</u> Empire. *Daniel 8:21 22*
 - The horn between the eyes of the goat is broken, and four notable horns come out.
 - The description of the fourth kingdom matches the **<u>Roman</u>** Empire.
 - The ten horns are ten kings and another shall rise after them the antichrist. Daniel 8:24

EFFORTS TO REVIVE THE ROMAN EMPIRE

- 800 A.D. CHARLEMAGNE NAMED "THE EMPEROR OF ROME."
- 962 A.D. OTTO I ESTABLISHES THE "HOLY ROMAN EMPIRE."
- 1806 A.D. NAPOLEON PROCLAIMS HIMSELF THE EMPEROR OF ROME. HE IS FOLLOWED BY BISMARCK, THE GERMAN IRON RULER, WILHELM I, AND HITLER.
- 1920S WINSTON CHURCHILL SAID THERE MUST BE A "UNITED STATES OF EUROPE."
- 1921 MUSSOLINI PROCLAIMS HIMSELF AS RULER OF THE ROMAN EMPIRE.
- 1936 MUSSOLINI CAPTURES ETHIOPIA. HITLER SAYS MUSSOLINI HAS ESTABLISHED THE REVIVED ROMAN EMPIRE.
- 1957 LEADERS OF SIX EUROPEAN COUNTRIES ESTABLISHED THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY IN ROME.
- 21ST CENTURY THE EUROPEAN UNION HAS A POLITICAL, ECONOMIC, AND MILITARY UNITY THROUGHOUT EUROPE. THIS MIRRORS THE STABILITY ROME GAVE TO THE SAME REGION.

CONCLUSION ONE TRUTH Given by ONE GOD to TWO MEN through TWO DREAMS

Head of Gold	Babylonían Empíre	Lion with Eagle's Wings



Follow Along Outline

Daniel – the prayer of a prophet - *Daniel 9:1-19*

- The prompting of the prayer, in the first year of Persian rule under Darius, Daniel came to an understanding of <u>Jeremiah's</u> prophecy in 25:11 and 29:10.
 - The Jews are going to return to Israel after <u>70</u> years in the Babylonian captivity.
 - Daniel is able to determine where he is in God's time simply by **reading** God's Word.
 - Determine where you are in God's time by **reading** God's Word.
- The promise of the prayer came from God based on God's mercy Daniel 9:4, 9, & 18

Daniel prayed when he knew where he was in God's timetable. Prayer doesn't change things. It changes me. God conforms me to His will.

- The plea of the prayer was that of confession and intercession.
 - 1. That God would bring them out of **<u>Babylon</u>**.
 - 2. That God would <u>forgive</u>.
 - <u>Confession</u> in Daniel's prayer was for his personal sins and the sins of his nation.
 - 3. That God would allow the <u>Temple</u> to be built in Jerusalem.
- The product of the prayer was:
 - The **prophecy** of the angel Gabriel
 - The <u>commendation</u> of God *not one word condemning Daniel is recorded in the Bible*

Gabriel – the prophecy of an angel - *Daniel 9:20-27*

- The prophecy unfolds a special plan for a special people in a special place.
 - The special people are the nation of **Israel**.
 - The special place is the holy city, Jerusalem Daniel 9:24
- The term "*seventy weeks*" is 490 years *Daniel 9:24*
- The special plan is to restore God's special people.
 - There are six steps to this plan, three negative and three positive:

Negative

- 1. Get rid of their rebellion.
- 2. Get rid of their sins.
- 3. Make reconciliation for their iniquity.

Positive

- 1. Bring them everlasting righteousness.
- 2. Seal up the vision and prophecy.
- 3. Anoint the most Holy.

To see what God is doing, look at two things:

- The Jewish people
- The city of Jerusalem.

After the Rapture - Before the Tribulation - Three things must be set in place

- 1. *Tyrant* the Antichrist
 - The "*prince that shall come*" in *Daniel 9:26* is the <u>Antichrist</u>. (The Messiah would arrive in Jerusalem 69 Weeks or 483 years after the command to go back and rebuild the city.)
 - ▶ In *Daniel 9:27* the "*he*" refers to <u>Antichrist</u>, the individual who is going to confirm a peace agreement with many for one week
 - Those ten horns of *Daniel 7:7* must develop into the Revived <u>Roman</u> Empire. (*Revelation 13:1*) The Antichrist is going to be a Gentile coming out of the Gentile world powers.
 - Out of those ten horns comes the <u>little</u> horn. The Antichrist must appear.
 - How in the world will the Jews accept a <u>Gentile</u> as their Messiah? Why haven't they accepted Jesus as their Messiah?
 - II Thessalonians 2:8. *God shall send them* [those who reject the truth] *strong delusion that they should believe a lie*, and they accept a Gentile messiah, a false messiah, the Antichrist.
 - Satan empowers the Antichrist with: *Revelation 13:2*
 - *his power*
 - his seat
 - great authority

- 2. *Treaty* Confirmed, not signed
 - *Daniel 9:27 He shall* confirm the covenant with many for one week. The Hebrew word "*Gabar*" means to confirm, to strengthen, not to sign. To do this you must have a treaty on the table and not working.
 - Consider the Camp David Accord and the Oslo Accords. Many multitudes of both Jews and Palestinians have been <u>killed</u> since the Oslo accords were signed, a definite sign that the treaties are not working.
 - The confirmation of the peace agreement starts the clock ticking on that seven year <u>Tribulation</u> period.
- 3. *Temple* The next Jewish Temple to be built on the Temple Mount
 - A Jewish rabbi in Jerusalem has a computer with the names of every male Jew who is qualified to be a priest. **28,000** are needed to serve because, as the rabbi says "we are going to build a Temple." The priestly garments and implements are already made.
 - The first ten string <u>harp</u> made in 2,000 years in Jerusalem brought tears to another rabbi, and he said, "When a ten string <u>harp</u> shows up, it is the time for the coming of Messiah."

CONCLUSION

The 70th week of Daniel requires a tyrant. It is believed he, the Antichrist, is alive on the earth today. It requires a treaty confirmed by him and a temple ready to be rebuilt. These three things happen in this seven year period. Before that the archangel shouts. The trumpet of God sounds, and WE ARE OUT OF HERE!

Regarding prophecy – We need to know today what is going to happen tomorrow so that the decisions we make today will be in line with God's perfect plan for tomorrow.

Regarding prayer – It doesn't change things. It changes me to conform to God's will. It did for Daniel. It did for Jesus. It will for me when I pray.

They came from the skies

Satan is dispatching his evil angels upon this world from the first heaven to wipe out Israel and Christians. They are the foe in our spiritual warfare, mighty powerful, but not omnipotent, omniscient or omnipresent.




Powerful Prayer of the Prophet

- Daniel is found **praying** and fasting for **three** weeks before the Lord. *Daniel 10:1-3*
- Prophecy again drove him to **prayer**.

Ambassador from above

- The description of the heavenly visitor Daniel 10:5-9
 - It is believed by some that this heavenly visitor was a pre-incarnate appearance of **Jesus Christ**.
 - Christ also appeared to Abraham, Moses, Jacob, Ezekiel and here to Daniel.



- The declaration of the heavenly visitor Daniel 10:10-17
 - He is hindered or kept from Daniel for three weeks by *the prince of the kingdom of Persia. Daniel 10:13*
 - This prince of Persia is not only a human **<u>national</u>** leader, but one embodied by an evil angelic being.
- The duty of the heavenly visitor Daniel 10:18-19
 - To calm and strengthen Daniel's fear and bring him <u>peace</u>.
- The determination of the heavenly visitor *Daniel 10:20*
 - He battles with the prince of Persia again and then with the prince of Greece.
 - The price of Greece is Antiochus Epiphanes

Origin of Satan

First, he was an angel of God. Job 38:4 - 7 gives us the first clue as to <u>when</u> angels were created.

- God created angels some time between His act of creating the <u>heavens</u> in Genesis 1:1 and the earth in Genesis 1:1
 - Angels were there to sing joyful praise to God for the beauty of the <u>earth</u> He had just created.
 - God created the angels for the purpose of <u>serving</u> Him.
- Angels did not fall during the <u>six</u> days of creation, since everything was good on the seventh day *Genesis 1:31*.
 - At some point between Genesis 1:31 and Genesis 3:1 One <u>third</u> of the angels fell and became evil angels.
 - A <u>demon</u> is actually an evil angel living in a human body.
 - In Genesis 3:1 <u>Satan</u> is on the scene.
- Isaiah 14 and Ezekiel 28 deal with the fall of angels.
 - **Lucifer** was his name when he was created.
 - <u>Satan</u> became his name when he fell.
- ▶ God cast Satan out of the third heaven and into the first heaven. *Ephesians 6:12*


The diabolical desire of the Devil

Satan's plan is to <u>ruin</u> God's plan.

- God's plan was to one day bring forth a Messiah. *Genesis 3:15*
- And He promises to do that through the Jewish people. Genesis 12:3

Satan wants to kill the Jews and thus prevent God from fulfilling His promises, including those concerning the Messiah, Jesus Christ.

- In the book of Esther, Haman, Prime Minister of the <u>Persian</u> Empire, makes a deal with King Ahasueras to kill all the Jews on the face of the earth.
- Satan dispatched an evil angel into the body of Haman, the prince of Persia, who was demonically possessed or controlled to do what he did.
- The prince of Greece, Daniel 11, Antiochus Epiphanes, leader of the northern part of Greece, enters Jerusalem, goes to the temple, takes a pig, pulls his dagger down its belly and throws the innards on the altar, thus desecrating the temple.



The prince of Persia, the prince of Greece, Herod the Great at the time of Jesus' birth, Adolf Hitler's World War II Holocaust, Yassar Arafat - are all examples of Satan's murderous plan in action.

Islam's Inception

Islam started in the sixth century by <u>Mohammed</u> in Mecca, which was the headquarters of idol worship of the world, the occult, demonism and witchcraft.

- Mohammed starts to worship a god, <u>Allah</u>. It is not the true God in another name. It is the moon god, the crescent moon being the symbol of the Islamic faith, something with which no one can co-exist.
- Islam is the fastest growing religion in the world (even in the United States), now claiming 25% of the world's population. The Koran is not a holy book. It calls for violence, the demise of all unbelievers (Jews and Christians).

What makes the nations come together? Satan dispatching from the first heaven an evil angel to take control of a world leader (Ephesians 6:12 - world rulers satanically energized).

- The evidences of the coming of the end is deception. *Matthew 24:4-5, 11, & 24*
- II Corinthians 11:13-15 speaks of false apostles, deceitful workers, Satan transformed into an <u>angel</u> of <u>light</u>, making great inroads even in the church.

CONCLUSION

We must understand where we are, go to prayer as Daniel did and put on the whole armor of God every day so we can withstand the spiritual invasion upon us from outer space.




The time of Jacob's trouble

- In the <u>second</u> half of the Tribulation there will be terrible judgments upon the earth
 - The <u>trumpet</u> judgments
 - The <u>vial</u> judgments.
 - Persecution of the most high saints will be intense.
 - Knowledge of <u>salvation</u> and through Jesus Christ will increase.
 - God will protect the Jewish people in <u>Petra</u> during this time of judgment.



"A time, times, and an half" - Daniel 12:7

- This equals 3.5 years that is the last half of the Tribulation period.
- It refers to the time of Jacob's trouble, also called the Great Tribulation.
- These are Jewish years, which are 360 days.
 - 1260 days
 - 42 months.



Chronicle of Christ-less kings

- The heavenly visitor describes five personalities to Daniel. Here is where we have the alignment of the nations. In Ezekiel 5:5 we see that God placed Jerusalem "*in the midst of the nations and countries that are round about her*."
- Ahasueras, king of <u>Persia</u>. Daniel 11:2 and Esther 1:1
 - He controlled from India all the way to Spain.
- Alexander the Great, king of <u>Greece</u>. Daniel 11:3.
 - He is that leopard with four wings and four heads, the belly of brass.
 - Verses 5 and 6 speak of the king of the south and king of the north, (all direction is based from the city of Jerusalem). **Egypt** and **Syria**.
- Antiochus the Great Daniel 11:10-20
- Antiochus Epiphanes a cruel, Jew hating Syrian king who desecrated the temple in Jerusalem - Daniel 11:21-35, Matthew 24:15
- Antichrist Daniel 11:36-45
 - He will do according to his will, exalt himself, magnify himself above every god, and rule and prosper *Daniel 11:36-37*
 - Lusts after power, riches, and pleasure. Daniel 11:38

Alignment of Nations - Daniel 11:40-45

- Antichrist will defend Israel by defeating Syria, and Egypt *Daniel 11:40-41*
- ▶ From 36 45 the words "he", "him", and "his" refer to Antichrist
- Who escapes his harm? Edom, Moab and Ammon, Three Biblical names for modern day Jordan. The location of <u>Petra</u>.
- Ethiopia and Libya are at his heels *Daniel 11:42-43*
- Tidings from the east and north trouble him *Daniel 11:44*
- In Ezekiel 38:5, 6 we find Ethiopia, Libya, Russia, modern day Turkey and Persia (modern day Iran).
- Israel is attacked from all directions, north, east, south, and west.
- These nations are ready to attack Israel, today.
- This will happen when Israel least suspects it when they dwell safely in the "land of unwalled villages" - Ezekiel 38:8, 11 During the first 3.5 years of the Tribulation
- Antichrist defends Israel, but it is Jesus Christ who truly protects them, Antichrist takes the credit.
- Antichrist then commands the Jews to rebuild their Temple. Daniel 11:45

CONCLUSION

We should use the truth that we gained from God's prophetic word to determine where we are in God's timeline of events, as Daniel did in Daniel 9:2.

As we anticipate the coming of Christ, may we make certain we are prepared to meet God, living pure and working productively until Christ does come.

Take the Word of God as my dear friends study it, allow it to challenge the people of God knowing better the plan of God to be willing to move into the will of God for the Glory of God.
