

#### Three Old Testament priest/prophets


•	was 30 years of age when he was taken into Babylonian captivity in 597 B.C. He had already qualified as a priest, but was never able to practice the priesthood.
•	was a priest who God called to be a prophet.
•	was a priest who God called to be a prophet and who returned to Jerusalem encouraging the people to rebuild the Temple.

# Three Diasporas and Aliyahs

•	In Genesis Jacob took his 70 family members into Egypt, dispersed from out of the land due to famine. 430 years later through the leadership of Moses and Joshua they are delivered (commemorated by the Feast of) and return two million strong.
•	The dispersion of the Jews to occurred in 605 B.C. with Daniel and the three Hebrew children, then Ezekiel in 597 B.C. and all the Jews in 586 B.C God raises up King Cyrus to allow the Jews to return to Jerusalem and build their Temple.
•	The third departure of the people being taken out of the land occurred in 70 A.D. when the was destroyed. The third return is in the process in our life time as described in Daniel 2:7. The Tribulation period is unfolding. God will bring to an end the times of the Gentiles.

- ▶ His hearers (Israel) are described as hard headed, stiff necked, impudent, like scorpions, a house.
